A minimum of 6 semester hours of electives must be at the 300 level or above.</p> <p><b>General Electives (9-41)</b> To be selected in consultation with an advisor to ensure that degree and graduation requirements will be satisfied.</p> <p>Students are required to earn at least 124 semester hours in order to graduate from CMU. 60 semester hours must be from a regionally accredited 4-year degree granting institution or equivalent. 40 of the semester hours must be 300 level courses.
