*A grade of "C" (2.0) or better is required to meet competency at CMU for these courses.

**Preferred course selection and required for the CMU Bachelor of Science in Administration Deviation from the preferred course selection will result in a modification to the remaining CMU degree/major requirements, with potential additional courses being needed.

***BAE 203 Principles of Economics (Micro) or BAE 204 Principles of Economics (Macro) is applicable to both Social Sciences and Business Courses requirements.
