Students are required to earn at least 124 semester hours in order to graduate from CMU. 60 semester hours must be from a 4-year degree granting institution. 40 of the semester hours must be 300 level courses. To comply with the Central Michigan University's College of Business Administration (CBA) 27 Semester Hour Rule an additional 18 semester hours of non CBA elective credits are required. Resulting in a minimum of 142 semester hours required to complete the degree requirements.
