***Although this course satisfies the statistical component associated with the Psychology major, PSY 211 Introduction to Psychological Statistics is the preferred course and better prepares students for PSY 285 Research Methods and may be taken at CMU. If PSY 211 is elected to be taken adjustments will be made to the remaining major requirements.
