<p><b>Written Communication (6)</b> *ENGL 151 English Composition I (3) *ENGL 152 English Composition II (3)</p> <p><b>Mathematics/Science (8)</b> 1. Successfully complete courses selected from two or more of the following subjects: Astronomy, biology, chemistry, earth science, mathematics, Geography 151, physical science or physics. <i>(It is strongly recommended that students select a science course with a scheduled laboratory period.)</i>  2. Pass the Mathematics Assessment or successfully complete at least three semester hours of mathematics from courses numbered *MATH 121 or higher.</p> <p><b>Social Science (12)</b> POLSC 151 Introduction to Political Science (3) **PSYC 151 General Psychology (3) Successfully complete courses selected from any of the following subjects: Anthropology, economics, geography, (except Geography 151), history, political science (except Political Science 151), social work or sociology.</p> <p><b>Computer Skills (0-4)</b> Successfully complete one of the following: CIS 130 Introduction to Computer Information Systems (3) MDTC 160 Mechanical Drafting and CAD I (4) WPR 102 Word Processing I (3) WPR 110 Personal Word Processing (2) Achieve a satisfactory score on the Computer Skills Assessment.</p> <p><b>Humanities (9)</b> **SPCH 151 Communication Fundamentals (3) <b>OR</b> ***SPCH 152 Public Speaking (3) Successfully complete a course selected from any of the following courses: Art, communications, English (excluding ENG 101 and English courses taken to meet written communications requirements), humanities, journalism, music, philosophy, or theater.</p> <p><b>Foreign Language (8)</b> The student must successfully complete eight semester hours of one foreign language. Students with a minimum of four semesters of one foreign language in high school may petition the dean of humanities/social sciences for a waiver of one course (four credits) of this requirement. Students are required to earn at least 124 semester hours in order to graduate from CMU. 60 semester hours must be from a 4-year degree granting institution. 40 of the semester hours must be 300 level courses.  This articulation guide represents a MACRAO fulfillment.  Please note that students must complete a minimum of 30 hours in Psychology with a minimum of 15 hours of Psychology course work at CMU.
