Please note that the amount of General Education and General Electives requirements may fluctuate based upon the concentration selected and those elective courses chosen as part of Associate of Applied Science degree at Wayne County Community College.</p> <p>Students are required to earn at least 124 semester hours in order to graduate from CMU. 60 semester hours must be from a 4-year degree granting institution. 40 of the semester hours must be 300 level courses.</p> <p>To comply with the Central Michigan University's College of Business Administration (CBA) 27 Semester Hour Rule an additional seven semester hours of non CBA elective credits are required. Resulting in a minimum of 131 semester hours required to complete the degree requirements.</p> <p>This articulation guide represents a University Program course by course fulfillment.</p> <p>Minimum credits taken at CMU 70</p>
